This contact can either be a positive or negative experience. In some unfortunate cases, contact can result in animals requiring urgent attention and care from our state's animal rehabilitators.



Formed in 2002, our goals are to:

- Provide procedural education to those who encounter an orphaned or injured animal
- Provide the necessary information to protect and care for wildlife in open space
- Inform the public of the role, work and importance of animal rehabilitators
- Provide direction and guidance to rehabilitators with on-site inspections, education and training
- Serve as a viable source of educational supplies and materials (i.e. National Wildlife Rehabilitators Alliance manuals and documents)
- Assist in new facility set-ups, maintenance, animal care and daily rehabilitation practices and operations.

Being a rehabilitator is not easy. It takes selfless dedication in addition to time, money and love expended to help all animals in serious need. Responding to requests for care from individuals to government agencies, rehabilitators contribute and play a vital role within our society.

- Gathering and providing the necessary volunteers, food and funds to various rehabilitation organizations when needed.

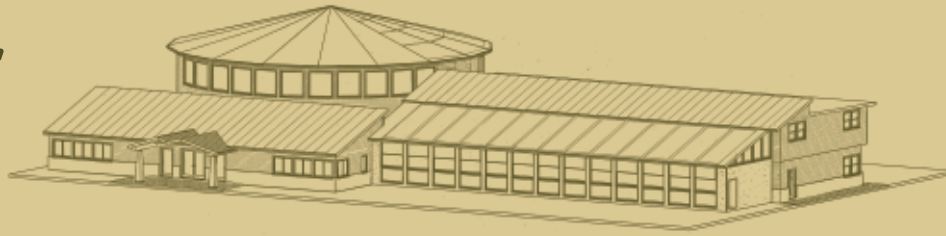
We are here to help in any way possible. When our rehabilitators call out for help, we promise to always be there.

The proposed building will be "green" and completely self-sustaining - utilizing wind and solar energy to power the daily operations. We also plan to adopt organic farming techniques which will provide some of the food needed for the nourishment of our injured animals.
